The Il Pompino will take a rear rack, plus mudguards front and rear... making it a strong candidate for a fixed-wheel commuter or winter training bike. Bigger clearances than usual for a fixie allow a wider tyre choice... It's versatile enough for other roles too; it will tackle most jobs short of [heavily] laden touring.'

At £499, the Il Pompino is a great value fixed-wheel bike to begin with but thanks to On-One we've got one to give away free. Frame and forks are reliable chrome-moly steel, with 120mm rear spacing. Wheels are On-One's 32-spoke track wheels, shod with Schwalbe Lugano tyres, while the fixed gear is 48x18 (72 inches). Finishing kit is all good quality stuff from On-One or Planet-X. The brakes are Shimano Deore LX cantilevers with Tektro levers.

The prize is an off-the-peg drop bar Il Pompino, but it's also available with flat bars or On-One's curvy Mary bars, or with a la carte spec options.
