PRIZE DRAW**WIN!**

As an introductory touring bike, the Dawes Vantage ticks all the right boxes. We reviewed one in the April-May 2011 issue of Cycle and found it offered the versatility you expect from a



tourer at a budget price. 'Tourers are not just for touring,' Chris Juden wrote. 'They're also ideal for commuting and shopping, wherever you want a bike that's efficient and easy to ride, that won't make you wet and dirty, that can take a bit of rough with the smooth and the load off your back. The Vantage will do all of that.'

The 24-speed transmission belies its budget. 'Shimano's entry-level shifting equipment gives pause to wonder why anyone pays more,' wrote Chris. 'Indexing was flawless rear and front.' The aluminium frame and cromoly

steel fork have 'all the key fittings', while the wheels are 'built tight enough to last a couple of tours or a year of commuting' without further attention. Even the tyres are good: 32mm Schwalbe Marathons. Chris said he found the Vantage 'reasonably quick, sure footed and comfortable'.

The Vantage is Dawes's entry-level bike in a range of ten tourers. Dawes also produces audax and sportive bikes, plus bikes for children (see this issue), for town use, mountain biking, and more. For further details, visit
